Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) A(H5N1)

The United States Department of Agriculture has confirmed the presence of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI), also known as the "Bird Flu," in over ten dairy facilities in Northern Colorado. It is crucial for dairy workers in Northeast Colorado experiencing respiratory symptoms or conjunctivitis to undergo testing.

To coordinate testing, individuals can reach out to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) at **303-692-2700 or 303-370-9395 for after hours.**

Testing for the HPAI A(H5N1) virus in human specimens is exclusively conducted at the State Public Health Laboratory. The collection of upper respiratory tract specimens and conjunctival swabs in viral transport media is necessary for accurate testing. Stay informed and take necessary precautions to to protect yourself.

Helpful Tips:

- Wear clean and protective clothing (gloves, coveralls, masks, goggles, hats).
- Wash your hands frequently.
- Don't drink raw milk.
- Clean areas around sick animals.
