

Frequently Asked **Questions**

Can someone be seen in person?

Yes- in their home, at walk-in clinics or through telehealth.

- For walk-in locations, call Colorado Crisis Services
- For in home visits, it may take up to 2 hours for professional to arrive.

Can someone request help for a family member or friend?

Yes- they can call Colorado Crisis Services to talk with a trained professional to find out how to get support for the person in crisis.

Is there a limit on how many times someone gets help?

No, there is no limit- a crisis may look and feel different for everyone. No matter what, someone can always turn to us or Colorado Crisis Services.
