The Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) benefit provides comprehensive and preventive health care services for Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid program) members age 20 and under along with administrative case management for pregnant adults.

EPSDT is key to ensuring that members receive appropriate preventive, dental, mental health, developmental and specialty services.

Services Covered

- Behavioral health screens and therapies
- Care coordination
- Dental visits every six months
- Developmental screens
- Health and prevention education
- Hearing services, including hearing aids
- Lab and blood tests such as testing for lead
- Transportation for services
- Vaccines (shots)
- Vision services, including eyeglasses
- Well visits (includes a sports physical) and sick visits, including primary care and specialist visits
