- Visit Colorado.gov/PEAK. In PEAK, go to your "mailbox" and select "update communication preferences" from that page.
- Use the Health First Colorado app on your phone. The app is free for members.
- Contact county department of human services (DHS).

### Renewal

Check the mail for the Renewal Form (formerly called Redetermination Paperwork).

Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program) will mail or email a letter about each member's health coverage; this is based on how member signed up to receive information (by mail or email).

- This letter will let someone know if they need to complete a renewal form to see if they are still eligible for Health First Colorado.
- The signature page, renewal form, and information asked for must be signed and returned within 30 days.
