CARE COORDINATION- JOANNAS CARING CORNER

- Care coordination is a free benefit to help you navigate care in any capacity you need. From managing a health condition to helping you understand your benefits to assisting with scheduling appointments and finding providers. Raina showed members how to complete the form online.
