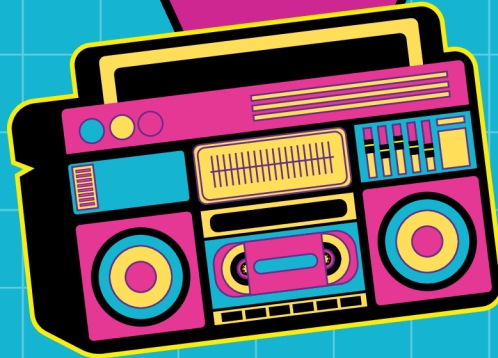

# CAT/CAS TRAINING DETAILS

## **Principles of Addiction Treatment**

This course explores different models of addiction, provides an overview of various treatment approaches, and highlights the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA) principles of effective care, along with evidence-based practices. The hybrid format includes two weeks of independent online learning, and one full 8-hour session held via Zoom.

**Dates:** June 15-25 online via the PDH site, 6/26 all day (8-5) live via Zoom

**Daily Schedule:** 9:00am–12:00pm and 1:00–3:00pm (≈5.25 hours/day)

## **Case Conceptualization & Documentation**

This course is designed to help counselors understand the clinical record and how it reflects the full continuum of client care. It includes an introduction to diagnosis using the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders, Fifth Edition, as well as ASAM Criteria for placement decisions. Participants will also explore screening and assessment tools, treatment planning, progress notes, and discharge summaries, along with key documentation elements such as informed consent, mandatory disclosures, and release forms. The hybrid format includes one week of independent online learning, and a half-day session held via Zoom.

**Dates:** July 13-15 online via the PDH site, 7/16 all day (8-5) live via Zoom

**Daily Schedule:** 9:00 am–12:00 pm and 1:00–2:30 pm (4.5 hours/day; ≈14 hours total)

## **Addiction Counseling Skills**

This course introduces a practical framework and counseling model for working with clients experiencing substance use disorders. It emphasizes a client-centered, counselor-guided approach grounded in the spirit and techniques of Motivational Interviewing. Participants will build and practice skills to help clients identify, explore, and make meaningful behavior changes. The hybrid format includes two weeks of online learning and one full 8-hour session held via Zoom.

**Dates:** July 27-August 6 online via the PDH site, 8/7 all day (8-5) via Zoom

**Daily Schedule:** 9:00 am–12:00 pm and 1:00–3:00 pm
