Outcomes & Follow-Up
Audit Outcomes and Subsequent Follow-Up Expectations

- NHP audits 100% of PCMP practices every year on a rolling 12-month cycle.
- Practices that pass are exempt from re-audit for 12 months.
- Practices that fail or partially fail enter the 90-day re-audit cycle and may require a CAP if issues persist.
- If the Audit reveals areas for improvement, these findings are shared with all PCMP organizations and available to any practice upon request.
