H.R.1 CHANGES

Beginning October 1, 2026, some immigrants who currently qualify for Medicaid may no longer be eligible for federally funded Medicaid coverage. The law limits eligibility to U.S. citizens and a smaller group of qualified immigrants, including:

- Lawful Permanent Residents (Green Card holders)
- Certain Cuban and Haitian entrants
- Individuals from Compact of Free Association (COFA) nations

Some immigrants who are lawfully present in the United States and may currently receive coverage could be impacted by these changes, including certain refugees, asylees, survivors of trafficking or domestic violence, individuals with humanitarian parole, and some people with Temporary Protected Status (TPS).

Coverage changes will depend on a person's immigration status and individual circumstances.

Individuals who may be affected should:

- Watch for notices from Health First Colorado, Medicare, or the Marketplace.
- Make sure their mailing address and contact information are up to date.
- Respond to any requests for information as soon as possible.
- Reach out to their health plan, county department of human services, or a certified enrollment assister if they have questions about their coverage.
