HEALTH FIRST COLORADO BENEFITS

Health First Colorado coverage includes, but is not limited to:

- Exams
- X-rays
- Cleanings
- Fillings
- Crowns
- Root Canals
- Extractions

- Periodontal Cleanings (deep cleanings used to treat gum disease)
- Dentures/Partials
- Dental Emergencies



ALL MEMBERS

Adults and children have no out-of-pocket costs for covered services, no annual maximum, no deductible or co-pays.

Plan covers a wide range of preventive and restorative care and emergency services.

Orthodontics are covered <u>IF</u> determined to be medically necessary for children only



Adult Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities Waiver

Waiver participants have the same adult benefit.

In addition, adult waiver participants may have access to additional services through the waiver.

CHILD HEALTH PLAN PLUS (CHP+) DENTAL BENEFITS

CHP+ coverage includes, but is not limited to:

- Diagnostic Services

 (annual exams and x-rays)
- Preventative
 Services (annual cleaning, fluoride and sealants)
- Basic Restorative

- Oral Surgery Services
- Endodontic Services
- Periodontic Services
- Removable Prosthodontics
- Orthodontics (covered only when medically necessary)



CHP+ Coverage

Child members are 0-18 years

Pregnant women

(Coverage ends 365 days after the last day of the month when the pregnancy ended)

\$1,000 in covered services each calendar year (Jan. 1-Dec. 31)



CHP+ Coverage

May have to pay an annual enrollment fee (\$0 for pregnant women)

No co-pays for covered diagnostic and preventive procedures

May have to pay small co-pays for other services. (\$0, \$5, \$10)

Limited orthodontic benefit for children

ssue

Evidence shows that oral healthcare during pregnancy is safe, recommended and can lead to improved oral hygiene and dietary habits for women and their families.

Strategies

- ✓ Outreach to members who are pregnant
- ✓ Member education on importance of oral health during pregnancy and oral health for young children
- ✓ Dental provider education on Smiling Stork program

Benefit

Reduce medical and dental costs associated with periodontal disease and improve patient experience/outcomes



Issue

Early childhood caries affects disadvantaged children more than other demographic populations. ECC is a preventable disease and very costly to treat.

Strategies

- Outreach to parents/caregivers of members about preventive dental care to prevent early childhood caries
- ✓ Provide parents/caregivers educational tools to assist with dental care and locating a dentist

Benefit

Reduce costs associated with ECC, establish preventive dental care during childhood and improve patient experience/outcomes

Dental Home



<u>Issue</u>

Fragmented care delivery which often results in poor coordination of care and possible patient safety concerns.

Strategies

- ✓ All Health First Colorado and CHP+ assigned to a Dental Home
- ✓ Reduction of unnecessary or duplicative services
- ✓ Better health outcomes
- ✓ Positive patient interactions
- ✓ Reduced cost of care

Benefit

Dental Home emphasizes overall wellness through improved oral health status, increased collaboration among providers and the promotion of health education.

Broken Appointments



Denta Quest.

<u>Issue</u>

Medicaid members miss scheduled appointments. Lost chair time and revenue for providers.

Strategies

- ✓ Providers enter missed dental appointments in DentaQuest portal
- ✓ Weekly outreach conducted to the members.
- ✓ Attempt phone calls to reach members to reschedule appointment
- ✓ Postcards mailed to members who cannot be reached via phone

<u>Benefit</u>

Increased provider satisfaction and improved rate of members who reschedule and keep dental appointment

Oral Health Ambassador Program

Designed to help promote awareness of Health First Colorado (Colorado Medicaid) and CHP+ dental benefits and the importance of oral health

Strategies

- ✓ Train community leaders, volunteers and oral health advocates as Oral Health Ambassadors
- ✓ Support Ambassadors with ongoing training and educational materials
- ✓ Ambassadors serve as trusted, culturally sensitive sources of information for hard-to-reach populations
- ✓ Provide dental education, promote the importance of early preventive care, and encourage knowledge and use of dental benefits
- ✓ Offer assistance and reduce barriers to care

Benefits

Increase use of preventive service and oral health knowledge while reducing barriers to care for individuals across Colorado


