- 18,453 student tests (157 positive, 0.85% positivity)
- 7,605 staff tests (62 positive, 0.82% positivity)

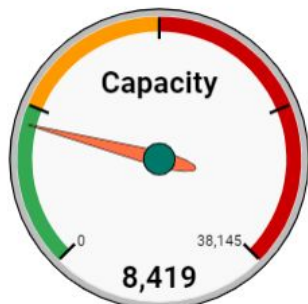

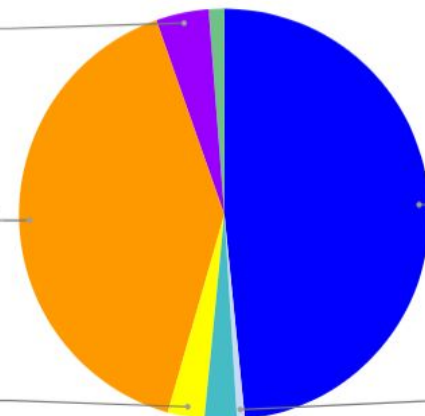

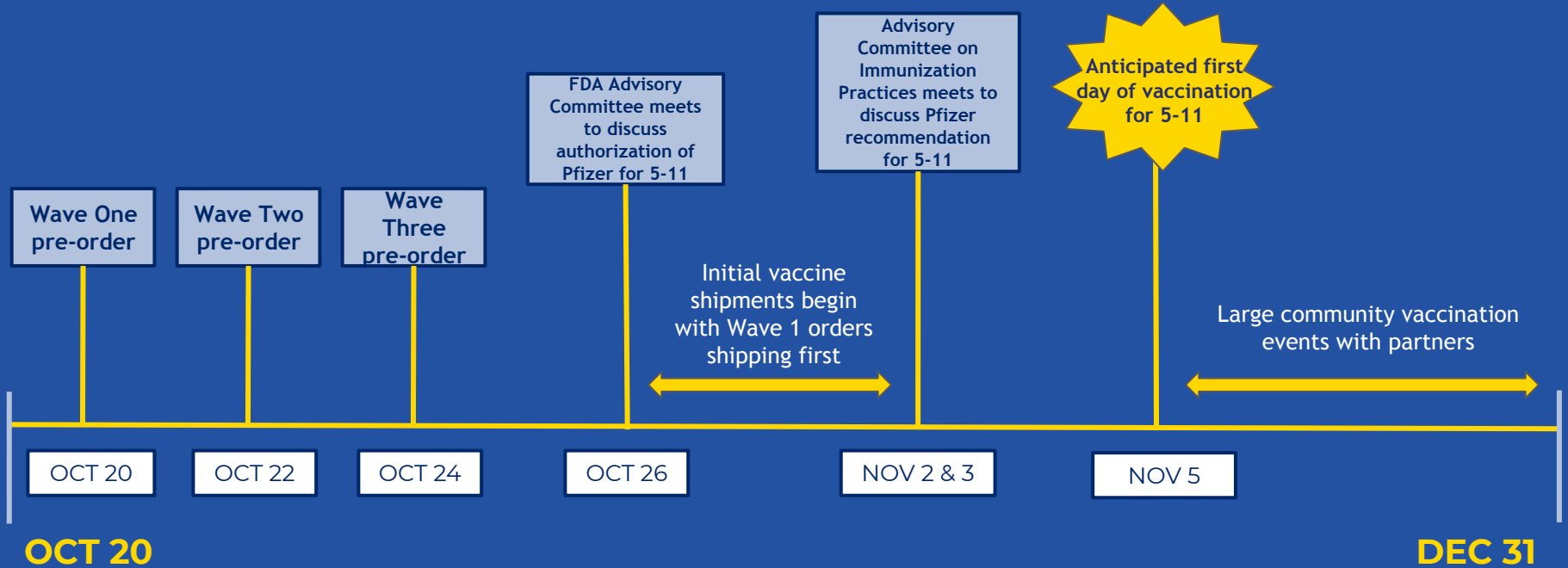
COVID-19 Vaccine for 5-17 Year-Olds

What we know and expect

- Pfizer vaccine is currently authorized for people 12 years and older.
 - The current Pfizer vaccine used for people 12+ cannot be used to vaccinate kids 5-11.
 - The pediatric Pfizer vaccine for kids 5-11 will be a new product with new packaging and new codes. Anticipated two-dose series, 21 days apart.
- CDC has enough vaccine to vaccinate ~28 million kids 5-11 nationwide.
- Colorado has an estimated 479,895 kids ages 5-11.
 - We anticipate 35-50% of parents will vaccinate their children 5-11 as soon as possible. This equates to 168,000 - 240,000 children.
- Colorado will receive 171,000 doses in week one.
 - 15% set aside for equity.
- Out of 1,245 COVID vaccine providers enrolled with the State, only about 200 of these intend to vaccinate kids 5-11.
- Still need to vaccinate more kids 12 - 17 where only 60.1% have received one dose.

GOAL: Vaccinate at least 50% of Coloradans aged 5-11 years old with first dose of COVID-19 vaccine by January 31.

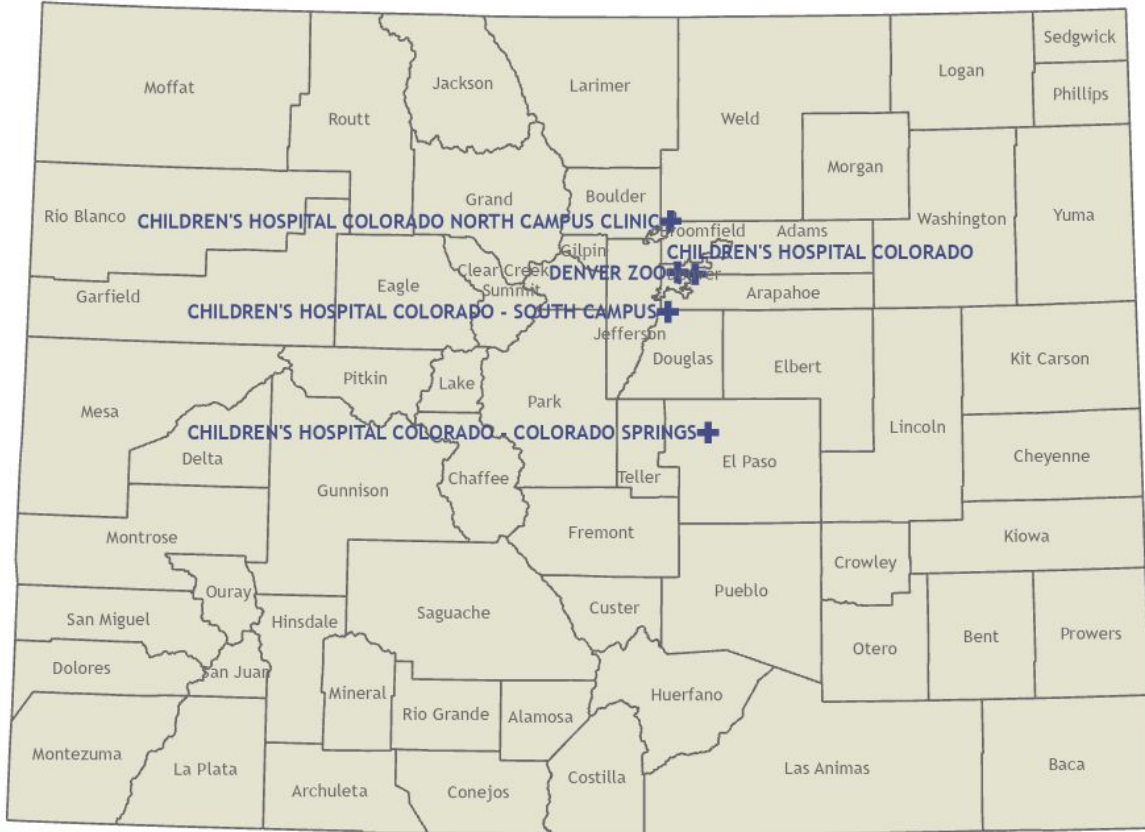
Who will vaccinate 5-17?

- Pediatric and family practice clinics
- School-based health centers
- Community health centers and safety net clinics
- Local public health clinics
- Retail pharmacies
- Large hospital systems
- CDPHE Vaccine Support Teams and mobile buses

Partnerships underway

- Collaboration with Children's Hospital Colorado to host weekly vaccine clinics during evening and weekend hours through December 31
 - Opportunity to vaccinate entire families for both primary series and booster doses along with focus on children 5-17
- Collaboration with American Academy of Pediatrics - Colorado Chapter, Colorado Academy of Family Physicians, and Immunize Colorado on shared messaging and promotion
- Confirmed partnership with 9Health, Colorado Rockies, and Denver Zoo
- Ongoing partnerships between school districts and mobile vaccination units (vaccine buses)
