The discussion included difficulty scheduling appointments and transportation difficulties. Benefit updates included new benefits starting July 1, 2024. SUD partial hospitalization Supportive housing SB23-174 - new services using a symptomology or social determinants of health diagnosis code to members under age 21. Midwife and doula services. Wellness & Prevention Focus April – Behavioral Health May – Family Planning June - Men's Health Peer Specialist Training July 29 – August 2, 2024 at North Range Behavioral Health. Free to Participants PHE Unwind Members have 90 days to return renewal packets after coverage ends. Members can have DHS back-date coverage to when it was lost. 	Regional Health Equity	 Alexandra LaCalamito presented the Regional Health Equity Plan. The regional demographics breakdown was explained. The strategic approach is guided by data from community input to develop interventions. With the goal to close disparities. Four areas were used as indicators of equity. COVID-19 Boosters Maternity & perinatal health Behavioral health Prevention The data derived from these areas will determine the approach used impact equity. Rural and frontier counties need to focus on dental access. Data analysis for oral evaluation shows the challenge is access. Either the dentist does not accept Medicaid or there is not a dentist at the FQHC. Dentriage is an app that helps members navigate dental pain and linking members to a dentist. Vaccine interventions and barriers Disseminate materials, mobile vaccines and align vaccines to well visits. Behavioral health interventions include support to providers with coding help, peer support through WISDO and connection to members after emergency department encounter. Prevention intervention includes changing the sports physical to a well child visit. This helps by getting a more comprehensive information within the visit. Prenatal and postpartum care intervention includes support to providers with coding and education to members.
