HTP Updates	Stephanie Brinks presented the Hospital Transformation Program • Focus areas: Reducing hospital readmissions, addressing social need

		 Social needs factors: housing, food insecurity, transportation, utilities, personal safety. Care coordination with RAE and provide resources. Interventions include notification of RAE, referral platform to identify community-based organizations (CBO). Partner with CBO or DRCOG to address social needs. Hospital data indicates housing and food are the most common areas of need. 	
		 Challenges include the patient not anticipating the social needs questions and a lack of certainty needs will be met. From hospital staff the challenges include discomfort asking the questions, trouble collecting data, "checking a box", and how follow through will happen. Hospitals are exploring, analyzing, and addressing disparities. RAE 2 has existing disparities in rural and frontier areas. 	
	WISDO Presentation	 Melissa Hildebrand presented Wisdo Health. WISDO is a social media type platform addressing loneliness and isolation. 72 % of Medicaid members report loneliness. Loneliness increases risk for other diseases. Treating loneliness reduces medical cost. Wisdo is offered in Colorado, for free, to all adults through 6/30/2026. WISDO is partnering with RAEs to spread the news of this platform to Medicaid members. Peer support and coaching is available to all seeking help for loneliness and isolation. High risk members, with chronic conditions, have case management available through a trained professional. Register online and pick community. Set goals, connect with peers, coaching and benefits. Weekly group coaching session offered. There are peers, helpers, guides and supervisors available. Materials available in Resources area on Wisdo.com
