Approval of June 2020 Minutes	 Quorum was met among voting members, allowing for minute approval to be voted on. Liz Hickman motioned to approve, Celeste Ewerte seconded. Meeting minutes approved without revision. 	 June's minutes will be posted to the <u>NHP</u> website; July's draft minutes will be sent via email to the group. 				
Regional Updates	 State Level PIAC Update – Joanna Martinson Joanna shared updates regarding the application process of selecting new PIAC members (state-level). Overall goal is to improve health and access for members and increase their satisfaction, and PIACs allow a change to engage members and ensure equity. Six (6) new members in the Fall. State Budget Update – Tammy Arnold State is looking for budget cuts across all departments and anticipate a \$3.3 billion shortall. State is trying to determine how to address revenue shortfall without a negative impact on providers. Healthy Communities work is transitioning to RAEs. Reduction of Dental benefits for members from \$1500 to \$1000. The implementation of this is still being determined by the Department, with a possible effective date of January 1, 2021. The reduction in benefit will only apply to adult members.					

Potentially Avoidable Costs

Presentation (Catherine Morrisey - NHP)

- Overview of FY19/20 efforts, as well as efforts that will span into the next fiscal year. NHP is continuing work across three episodes of care: Diabetes, Pregnancy/Maternity, and Depression/Anxiety.
 - PowerPoint presentation shared with the group included examples of interventions completed in the past year, relevant data, and next steps.
 - PAC work has a lot of layers so the group was encouraged to outreach with any questions or comments that could not be addressed in the overview shared at PIAC.

Healthy Communities Transitions

Presentation (Lynne Bakalyan, Beacon and Tammy Arnold, NHP)

- Healthy Communities is transitioning under the RAE as part of budget shortfalls.
- Presentation by Lynne and Tammy addressed the following:
 - o New Member Onboard
 - o EPSDT Outreach
 - Medical Necessity
 - Well Visit Outreach
 - o Dental Visit Outreach
 - Prenatal Outreach
 - Member Services Staff are well versed in Motivational Interviewing
- Onboarding Call once a month, which will be recorded and posted on website for those who cannot attend.
 - Catherine asked if there is possibility of changing up the times at which these trainings occur, as some members may not be able to attend from 11AM-12PM. This will be explored by Beacon.
- Members from the group expressed that a training would be helpful for their agencies; Lynne to follow-up on these activities.
